'Rejoice in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven' Luke 6:22

In the 'Sermon on the Plain' of St Luke, which is different from St Matthew's version of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus presents four blessings and four woes. Prior to this section, Jesus chooses twelve apostles whom He now intends to tell what it means to be His disciples and how they are to live their lives. Jesus' eight statements offer a disciples' manual for this world. He wants them (us) to embrace, not simply a behavioural change, but a real attitudinal change, a change from deep within the heart towards all kinds of life situations. For example, it is by giving up everything (detaching from the perishable things) that one learns how to be truly happy, even in poverty, hunger, mourning and persecution. Yet, the cost of Christian discipleship is nothing compared to the blessings Jesus promises us.
