

Luke brings together 3 distinct bits in Jesus Christ's teaching because they are interrelated and follow on naturally one from the other: the blind leading the blind; removing the splinter from your own eye; the sound tree producing good fruit.

We are all too well aware of just how easy it is for us to see the faults of others while remaining blind to our own inadequacies. We easily see the mistakes other people make and we are easily alert to their hypocrisies and inadequacies. But we ourselves, are so immersed in our own lives that we find it difficult to observe our own inadequacies and human faults. We fail to notice that we fall well short of the standards we expect from others.

But as Christians, we need to look into our own lives, to see our own faults and aim to overcome them to become like the sound tree that produces good fruit and live as true Disciples of Jesus Christ. Let us pray to God, our Father, that we may become people who serve the Lord with all our hearts in the best way we can and make a real contribution to the parish community, to the Church as a whole and the world.
