This weekend, the Gospel message presents the well-known story of Martha and Mary. As Jesus visits their home, Martha busily serves while Mary sits at His feet, listening. Martha, overwhelmed and frustrated, asks Jesus to tell Mary to help her. Instead, Jesus gently reminds Martha that Mary has chosen "the better part," which will not be taken from her. This passage invites us to reflect on the balance between action and contemplation in our own lives. Like Martha, we are often anxious and distracted by many tasks. Yet Jesus calls us to pause, listen, and be present to Him. It's not that service is unimportant, but that our work should flow from a deep relationship with Christ. In our busy world, we must remember to make time for stillness and prayer, placing Jesus at the centre of our hearts and allowing His presence to guide our actions.
