'Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of one's possessions' Luke 12:15

This weekend's Gospel reminds us of the danger of placing our trust in possessions. Jesus tells the parable of the rich man who builds bigger barns to store his wealth, only to die that very night. His story challenges us: are we storing up riches for ourselves, or are we becoming "rich in the sight of God"?

In a world that prizes success and accumulation, this Gospel urges us to reflect on what truly lasts. Wealth, status, and comfort are temporary. But acts of love, compassion, and generosity echo into eternity.

As disciples, we are called to hold our possessions lightly and to live with a spirit of detachment and gratitude. Let us invest more in relationships, in community, and in service to others.

May our hearts be rooted not in what we own, but in who we are before God.
