The core message of today's Gospel is *faith*. We are all invited to join the Apostles as they plead with Jesus, "Lord, increase our faith." That leaves us with the question: what is faith? Too often we associate faith with saying prayers and performing ritualistic practices; whilst all of these things may have their specific roles, *faith* is much more.

The Apostles in today's Gospel are unsure of their faith; with deep sincerity, they are convinced they need much more of it. They are not afraid to approach Jesus with their doubt. Jesus' response is that if one's faith is genuine, however little it may seem (even like a grain of mustard), one could do incredible things. Faith is tangible and is manifested in our attitudes and actions. The one prayer that should always be on our lips and in our hearts is "Lord, increase my faith ... help my unbelief"
