Ps1 16th November, 2025 (Pg164) YEAR C THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY

In the Gospel reading of this Sunday, Jesus talked about turmoil and distress, persecution and revolutions, disasters and tragedies. For sure, this certainly is something that is dark to hear. But in spite of the dark overtones, there is an underlying message of hope. Because Jesus tells us this, and we have to keep it carefully in mind: "Settle it, therefore in your minds, not to meditate beforehand how to answer, for I will give you a mouth and wisdom which no one of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict." In other words, Jesus is telling us to not despair because it isn't we who are to prepare our own defence, it is He Himself who will give us the eloquence we need and the wisdom that none of our opponents will be able to resist or contradict. So, in the face of devastation, there is consolation. What seems to be hopeless, there is hope.

Therefore, the Lord encourages us to persevere in righteousness and endure difficult moments. By warning that the Temple of Jerusalem would be destroyed despite its elegance and greatness, Jesus Christ also reminds us that nothing in this world will last forever, no matter how precious they are to us. The only thing that will endure is our faith in Him. Even though in our families, offices, businesses, careers, studies, etc., and in our world at large, we face from time to time difficulties that at times question our faith, if we endure all these patiently, as Jesus Christ tells us, we will have enough reasons to smile at the end and, of course, "the sun of righteousness will rise on us with healing in its wings."
