Fourth Sunday of Advent Ps4 28th December (pg90)

As Advent nears its end, the Gospel draws our attention to Joseph's quiet and faithful response to God. Faced with uncertainty and fear, Joseph listens to God's message and chooses trust over doubt. His righteousness is revealed through compassion, humility, and obedience, as he accepts Mary and the child she carries. In doing so, Joseph makes room for Emmanuel, God-with-us, entering the world.

This final Sunday of Advent invites us to reflect on how we respond when God's plans differ from our own. Like Joseph, we are called to welcome Christ into our lives with openness and courage. As we prepare for Christmas, may we learn to trust God's presence in the ordinary and unexpected moments of our daily lives.

Christmas

On Christmas Day, we rejoice in the mystery of the Word made flesh. God does not come with power or grandeur, but as a vulnerable child, born into the simplicity of human life. In Jesus, Emmanuel, God draws near to us, sharing our joys, struggles, and hopes. The light that shines from the manger is not distant or abstract; it enters our world to transform it from within.

This feast invites us to receive Christ anew, not only as a memory of the past, but as a living presence among us today. As we celebrate, we are called to welcome this divine light into our hearts and homes, and to carry it outward through acts of love, mercy, and peace for all.
